

LABOUR DAY PARADES

MONDAY SEPTEMBER 5th

TORONTO 150th PARADE

For a **Bus** ride to the Parade from Etobicoke; meet at **Boston Pizza parking lot at 1602 The Queensway, Etobicoke**. The Bus leaves at **7:45am SHARP**. If meeting downtown at the Parade, meet on the west side of University Ave., north from Queen St. W. to Armoury St., section 2.
