## Job Posting

The Boilermaker Local 128 Apprenticeship and Training is seeking a weld shop instructor for our Burlington location. We are looking for an individual that will promote a positive attitude towards our union members and the contractors we work for.

The requirements for the position are:

- Must be familiar with Code 47.1 CWB, and ASME 9 Boiler and Pressure Code.
- Must have had the 4 BCA welding qualifications and can still achieve them if not currently valid.
- Must be able to teach all weld processes, GTAW, SMAW, FCAW, MIG and Carbon Arc.
- Ability to perform lay out and be proficient with a Cutting torch, Plasma Arc and Gouging

Job Duties and Responsibilities:

- Coordinate CWB & TSSA testing
- Communicate with contractors to schedule weld testing
- Prep for weld tests both CWB and TSSA
- Record and maintain all welding qualifications
- Assist in optimizing existing welder training and the expansion of other welding training programs
- Confirm weld tickets are current for both journeypersons and apprentices, including monitoring the out of work list and scheduling shop time for members to attend welder upgrading.
- General shop maintenance
- Purchasing and ordering of shop equipment and consumables
- Teach/Instruct members to weld structural plate as well as tube/pipe.
- Assist in the growth of training and upgrading our members to meet the demands in the future
